**ADMINISTERING MEDICATION TO STUDENTS**

Students requiring medication at school shall be identified by parents/guardians to the student's building principal. The principal, in turn, shall assume authority for involving designated school personnel in the administration of the medication.




School personnel may administer prescription and non-prescription medication to students only under established conditions and in accordance with state law and established District procedures. No school personnel, other than a health care professional, may be required to administer medication to a student by any means other than ingestion



