

# **JACK OMER SCHOLARSHIP**

## **BRIEF HISTORY:**

Mr. Omer began teaching at Mayville High School in 1965. He taught social studies and coached football and track. In 1972, he assumed the position of athletic director. As a coach, Jack Omer set the best record in the history of Mayville with 11 Conference Championships, by winning 32 of 35 games in the Flyway Conference. In 1983, he was recognized by the WHSFCA as the District VI Coach of the Year (Class B) and received the Victors and Service Awards. The memory of Jack Omer was honored by his induction into the Wisconsin High School Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame on March 23, 1985. This scholarship was first awarded in 1985.

## **WHO IS ELIGIBLE:**

This scholarship will be awarded to graduating seniors (one boy and one girl) who show outstanding athletic ability and academic and leadership achievement. The students must be furthering their education at a public or private college, university, or technical school. The course of study must lead to a diploma, associate or baccalaureate degree. If in the opinion of the Selection Committee, there aren't a qualified female and male applicant, the committee can select two candidates of the same sex. The graduating Mayville High School student athletes must have participated in two or more sports and earned a varsity letter in at least two different sports. Varsity managers and varsity cheerleaders also qualify. Applicants must have maintained at least a 2.5 grade point average.

## **AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:**

Two scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$500 each. The award amounts could vary depending on available funds.

## **HOW PAID:**

One half of this scholarship is awarded at the beginning of each semester, upon verification of enrollment. Contact the Mayville Athletic Booster Club for payment.
